

Chiawen Kiew is the Advisor in the Office of Anti-Corruption and Integrity (OAI) at the Asian Development Bank (ADB), where he manages the front office operations of OAI overseeing policy and strategic advice on anti-corruption and integrity policies and controls, developing integrity capacity building to ADB's developing member countries, technology services, and knowledge and communications.
