

Henrik Malmquist is the Head of Service (Investigation). Mr. Malmquist joined UNHCR in 2015 after twenty years' experience from different managerial positions within the Swedish Police, including several international assignments. Among numerous national assignments, mainly in the investigative branch, he was a Commissioner and Head of National Bureau of Investigation of Sweden, Head of the local and regional CIDs and Deputy Head of International Police Affairs Division. Important international assignments include Head of EUPOL COPPS Mission in Palestine, Director of Security and Public Safety Directorate, OSCE Mission in Kosovo and Head of Swedish Desk of Europol in the Hague.

Mr. Malmquist has been a Member of the Europol Management Board between 2013 and 2015, and he was the Head of EUPOL COPPS Police and Rule of law Mission in Ramallah between 2010-2012. In 2009, he was assigned by the Swedish Government as Chairman of the Europol Ad Hoc Working Group for implementation of the Europol Council Decision during EU Swedish Presidency.

He has a Master of Laws at the University of Lund, as well as a Diploma in International Studies at The Johns Hopkins University, School of Advanced International Studies, Bologna Center.
