

Luc Ferran is Chief of Investigations Unit 2 at the Investigations Branch of UNFPA's Office of Audit and Investigations Services (OAIS). He has been with UNFPA OAIS since April 2018. Prior to UNFPA, Mr. Ferran worked with UNHCR IGO based in Nairobi, Kenya as Senior Investigations Officer and earlier with the International Rescue Committee (IRC) as Director for Integrity and Accountability.
