

Paul Catchick started his career in British Customs where he worked in tax audit, insolvency fraud and the investigation of organised crime and money-laundering. He later joined the UK Serious Fraud Office where he worked on the British Aerospace corruption case before being seconded to the Sierra Leone Anti-Corruption Commission.

Paul's career in the international sector began with UN OIOS before he moved to the OSCE to establish its investigation function. He is currently the Director of Investigations and Counter-Fraud at Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance.
