She was the Assistant Treasurer of the Treasury Services Division, where she managed a variety of treasury operations activities, including cash management, bonds and derivatives management, transaction banking (settlements, and payments), treasury systems management, organizational resilience, and was heavily involved in digital agenda.

She has 30 years of professional experience in international financial institution, corporate banking, and fund management. Prior to joining ADB, she set up private fund management business, managed mutual and private funds, and conducted equity research. She started her career in auditing in Price Waterhouse and shifted to corporate banking with Citibank, N.A., before diversifying into fund management.
