

Stephen Zimmermann was appointed in March 2019, as the Director, Office of Internal Audit and Investigations at UNICEF, where he oversees teams responsible for assurance and advisory services, as well as investigations into fraud, corruption and misconduct across the organization's global operations. Before joining UNICEF, Mr. Zimmermann was the Senior Adviser to the Governance Global Practice of the World Bank where he helped guide the Bank's anti-corruption, justice and rule of law work.

He was previously the Director of Operations for the World Bank Integrity Vice Presidency (INT) where he oversaw teams charged with detecting, investigating, sanctioning and preventing fraud and corruption in Bank-financed activities and had a leading role in developing the World Bank's integrity agenda. Earlier, Stephen served in leadership roles for the Inter-American Development Bank, the United Nations Oil for Food Program, and as an Assistant United States Attorney and a lawyer in private practice.
