

Matthew Fowler is the Chief of the Office of Institutional Integrity (OII). Prior to his appointment in 2023, Mr. Fowler served in several leadership roles in OII including overseeing integrity risk management in private sector operations and anti-money laundering compliance for IDB activities. Mr. Fowler joined the IDB in 2009 as a Private Sector Integrity Officer in OII.

Mr. Fowler is a U.S. attorney specialized in the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA) and anticorruption compliance. Before joining the IDB, he worked as in-house FCPA counsel for a Fortune 50 company, and on FCPA and other international matters for private U.S. law firms.
