Cambodia's Updated Nationally Determined Contribution



- Submitted to the UNFCCC in December 2020
- Setting target to decrease emissions by 41.7 percent from the business-as-usual scenario by 2030
- Identifies 33 mitigation actions for all related sectors for implementation, five of them are assigned to Ministry of Public Works and Transport:

No. Mitigation Actions by Transport Sector

- 1 Promote integrated public transport in main cities
- 2 Enhance maintenance and inspection of vehicle
- 3 E-mobility
- 4 Establish green belts along major roads
- 5 Shift long distance freight from trucks to train

Long-term Strategy for Carbon Neutrality



- Submitted to the UNFCCC in December 2021
- Committed to keep the global average temperature increase below 1.5°C
- Identifies 35 key mitigation actions for all related sectors for implementation, also five of them are assigned to Ministry of Public Works and Transport:

No. Key Mitigation Actions by Transport Sector

- 1 More use of public transport 30% modal share in urban areas by 2050
- 2 Moderate penetration of EVs 70% for motorcycles, and 40% for cars and urban buses by 2050
- 3 Increased fuel efficiency for ICE vehicles
- 4 Rail for freight and passengers
- 5 CNG penetration of 80% for inter-regional buses and trucks by 2050

Comprehensive Intermodal Transport & Logistics System Master Plan 2023-33

- Approved by the former PM in August 2023
- Vision: Improve and develop a sustainable and inclusive intermodal transport network and logistics system to support the sustainable economic growth
- Identifies 174 projects with the total investment of 36.6 billion USD by 2033 in different modes as follows:
