Henry Rupiny Kerali studied Civil Engineering and obtained a PhD from the University of Birmingham, UK in 1986 focusing on transport for development. He subsequently joined the academic staff as a Research Fellow and was appointed a full Professor in 2001. He led the international research program that developed HDM-4. He joined the World Bank in 2003 as a Transport Specialist and was appointed Transport Sector Manager in 2009. In 2012, he was appointed Country Director for Armenia, Azerbaijan and Georgia based in Tbilisi. From 2015, he was Country Director for Ghana, Liberia, and Sierra Leone, based in Accra, and subsequently for Afghanistan based in Kabul from 2019. He retired from the World Bank in 2022 after serving for nearly 20 years. Professor Kerali is a Fellow and Chartered Civil Engineer with experience in a broad range of projects within the transport sector.
