

Antonio Miceli first worked for the Italian National Police as "Commissioner of Police" before joining UCLAF in 1993, which became OLAF in 1999. In UCLAF/OLAF, he was initially an investigator and then Head of Sector dealing with fraud and irregularities in several areas (structural funds, direct expenditure and internal investigations). In 2002, he moved to the Directorate-General for Justice, Freedom and Security to work in the "Fight against organised crime Unit". He joined the Directorate-General for Agriculture in 2003 as Head of the "Internal Audit Unit".

From 2006 to 2011, he worked in the Directorate-General for Research as Head of the "Internal audit Unit" and latterly as Head of the "Business Processes and management reporting Unit". In 2011, he returned to OLAF as Head of the "Direct expenditure investigative Unit" and served for one year as "Acting Director of Directorate A". In June 2014, he was appointed Head of the investigative Unit on "New financial instruments, international organisations and neighbouring countries". In 2019, he took up the post of Head of the "Internal Investigations Unit". Since 16 September 2024, he is the Acting Director of OLAF's "Directorate A – Expenditure – Operations and Investigations".
