

Conserving Water Sources

Source Protection for Sustainable Water Management



In order to reduce water stress, water resource conservation and its sustainable management is crucial. Hence, Environment and Public Health Organization (ENPHO), in partnership with Bremen Overseas Research and Development Association (BORDA) and in close collaboration with Godawari Municipality implemented the project "Integrated Urban Water Management at the Center of Municipal Public Services", from January to December, 2020 to renovate and conserve four water sources in Godawari Municipality.

Under the project, optimized water infrastructure were constructed with major focus on disaster resilient structure, protection of catchment area and the provision of safe water delivery system. The renovated water sources are Basuki, Bishankhunarayan, Ghattekhola and Champi located in Godawari Municipality. The renovated sources benefitted **1049** HHs with individuals beneficiaries of **1680** from Basuki source, **1236** from Biskhankhunarayan source, **1302** from Ghattekhola source and **2076** from Champi source.
