

ACCESS FOR SAFE WATER

REJUVENATING RESOURCES

To support the municipalities for improving the lives of the people through easy and safe access to their natural water resources, Environment and Public Health Organization (ENPHO) in partnership with Bremen Overseas Research and Development Association (BORDA) and in close collaboration with Godawari and Kirtipur Municipalities renovated and rejuvenated five traditional stone spouts under "Intergrated Urban Water Management at the Center of Municipal Public Services", project from January to December 2020. The action aimed to ease the water-stress prevalent among the people living in the municipalities.

For the activity, ENPHO coordinated with local stakeholders of the municipalities to identify, renovate and

rejuvenate five traditional stone spouts. The renovated traditional stone spouts are *Pooring Gaa Hiti, Pako Hiti* and *Sheraphata Hiti* in Godawari Municipality and *Bharkhe Hiti* and *Aajudega Kuwa* in Kirtipur Municipality. This action served total 405 HHs with individual beneficiaries of 120 by *Pooring Gaa Hiti*, 900 by *Pako Hiti*, 210 by *Sheraphata Hiti*, 675 by *Bharkhe Hiti* and 225 by *Aajudega Kuwa*.
