## **Climate Change-Gendered Experiences**

□ **Vulnerability:** Women are 14 times more likely to die in natural disasters. (UNDP)

- □ **Resource Access:** 70% of the world's poor are women, lacking access to land and finance. (UN Women)
- □ **Burdens:** Women spend 16 million hours daily fetching water, impacting health and income. (WHO)
- □ Health Impacts: Indoor air pollution causes 4.3 million premature deaths annually, affecting women and children. (WHO)
- Decision-making: Women hold only 24% of parliamentary seats globally. (UN Women)
- □ **Economic Disparities:** Women farmers face heightened risks from climate-related crop failures. (Oxfam)
