Ms. Chia-Tern Huey Min is presently overseeing International Tax Affairs and Relations, Investigation and Forensics, as well as the divisions responsible for indirect taxes (i.e., Goods and Services Tax, Property Tax & Stamp Duties) at the IRAS. Ms. Huey Min is Singapore's representative to the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development Inclusive Framework on base erosion and profit shifting (BEPS) and sits on its Steering Group. She also participates in the Task Force on Digital Economy. In addition, Ms. Huey Min is a member of the Steering Group for the Global Forum on Transparency and Exchange of Information for Tax Purposes and has been chairing the Peer Review Group since 2016. Prior to that, she held the role of the Vice-Chair from 2010 to 2015.

In addition to her IRAS appointment, Ms. Huey Min was concurrently the Chief Executive Officer of the Tax Academy of Singapore from 2007 to 2013. From 2005 to 2007, Ms. Huey Min was the Assistant Commissioner in charge of the Tax Policy & International Tax Division at IRAS. During her secondment to the Ministry of Finance, Singapore, from 2003 to 2005, she was the Chief Tax Policy Officer.

Outside of IRAS, Huey Min is serving as a board member at SATA Commhealth and on Industry Advisory Committee of the Accountancy School at Singapore Institute of Technology. She also served as a council member of the CPA Australia.
