AGLAÉE DEGROS is professor and head of the Institute of Urbanism at Graz University of Technology (TU Graz) and honorary science fellow at the Vrije Universiteit in Brussels (VUB).

In 2001, with Stefan Bendiks, she founded the urbanism and architecture firm Artgineering. She has held various teaching positions and visiting professorships: at Delft University of Technology (TU Delft), Rotterdam Academy of Architecture and Urban Design (RAvB), VUB, the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna, Vienna University of Technology (TU Wien), the Politecnico di Milano (Polimi), and the Harvard Graduate School of Design (GSD), among others.

Aglaée Degros is a co-author of books such as Public Space and the Challenges of Urban Transformation in Europe, Traffic Space is Public Space, Territorial Justice, Basics of Urbanism, Towards Territorial Transition, Territorial Urbanism Now! and Courage. She regularly serves on the jury of international urban planning and design competitions.

She currently serves as an expert for the Flemish Region's Chief Architect, Brussels-Zaventem Airport and the Asian Development Bank.
