BRIEF BACKGROUND

- APOAMF -Urban poor federation composed of 10 Local Peoples Organizations in Pasig
- In 2009 shortly after the devastation of typhoon ketsana families living along Manggahan Floodway were subjected to massive eviction threat and distant relocation program of the government.
- Arroyo(2009) and Aquino Governments (2010-2016)mandated relocation of informal settler families estimated at 100,000 along major waterways, creeks, canals that are high risk areas during floods and typhoons.

Families along East and West Bank along Manggahan Floodway in Pasig began to receive news of eviction and demolition threats.





- **Resisting Eviction the establishment of APOAMPF**
- APOAMF aims and process : Pursue their stand on safe and permanent tenure and livelihood security thru, onsite, near site and in city resettlement. Through the support of Community Organizer Multiversity, APOAMF build their capacity in responding many issues they face such as Eviction, Basic Services, DRR, Livelihood and Peace and order
- The People's Plan is the community's counterproposal to the government's plan of distant relocation is a participatory and community consensus based alternative to distant relocation.. This includes the community's formulating a vision of itself and its goals of development and security of tenure, a bottom up approach to development decisions.

DAMAYAN HOA BACKGROUND



- Damayan HOA was established in 1990 at Sitio Lumang Ilog, Brgy. San Juan, Taytay, Rizal with at least 2,500 members.
- Our community is composed of 3 zones with a total of 58 blocks.
- The land occupied by ours is covered under Presidential Proclamation 458, s. 1994, declaring the Embankment-Floodway as socialized housing.

- construction of riprap in 2011 that provides protection on the entire community
- Accessing funds and DRR-related equipment and materials
- Accessed 4.5 million fund for the construction of 3-Storey Evacuation Center located at Block 67, Damayan-Floodway, Taytay, Rizal.
- The model house is people's plan model of community on resilient housing.
