As a Chief Counsel in the legal department of EBRD, Mr. Kearney advises the EBRD's General Counsel on special projects. As EBRD's Enforcement Commissioner, Mr. Kearney is the 1st tier decision-maker for EBRD's sanctions and debarment system - the Enforcement Policy and Procedures. Mr. Kearney joined EBRD in 1998, became a Chief Counsel in 2006 and was appointed as Enforcement Commissioner in 2015. Earlier roles included heading teams dealing with Banking Operations, Corporate Recovery, Corporate and Knowledge Management, as well as the legal aspects of the development of EBRD's Carbon Credit product line.

Prior to joining EBRD, Mr. Kearney worked for Salans Hertzfeld & Heilbronn, in London, and for McCann FitzGerald, in Dublin and in London. Mr. Kearney also acted as Assistant Company Secretary within the GPA Group, while on secondment from McCann FitzGerald. Mr. Kearney is an Irish citizen and holds a B.A. (Mod. Leg. Sci.) and an M.A., both from Trinity College, Dublin. Mr. Kearney was admitted as a solicitor, in Ireland, in 1988, and has been admitted as a solicitor, in England and Wales, since 1991.
