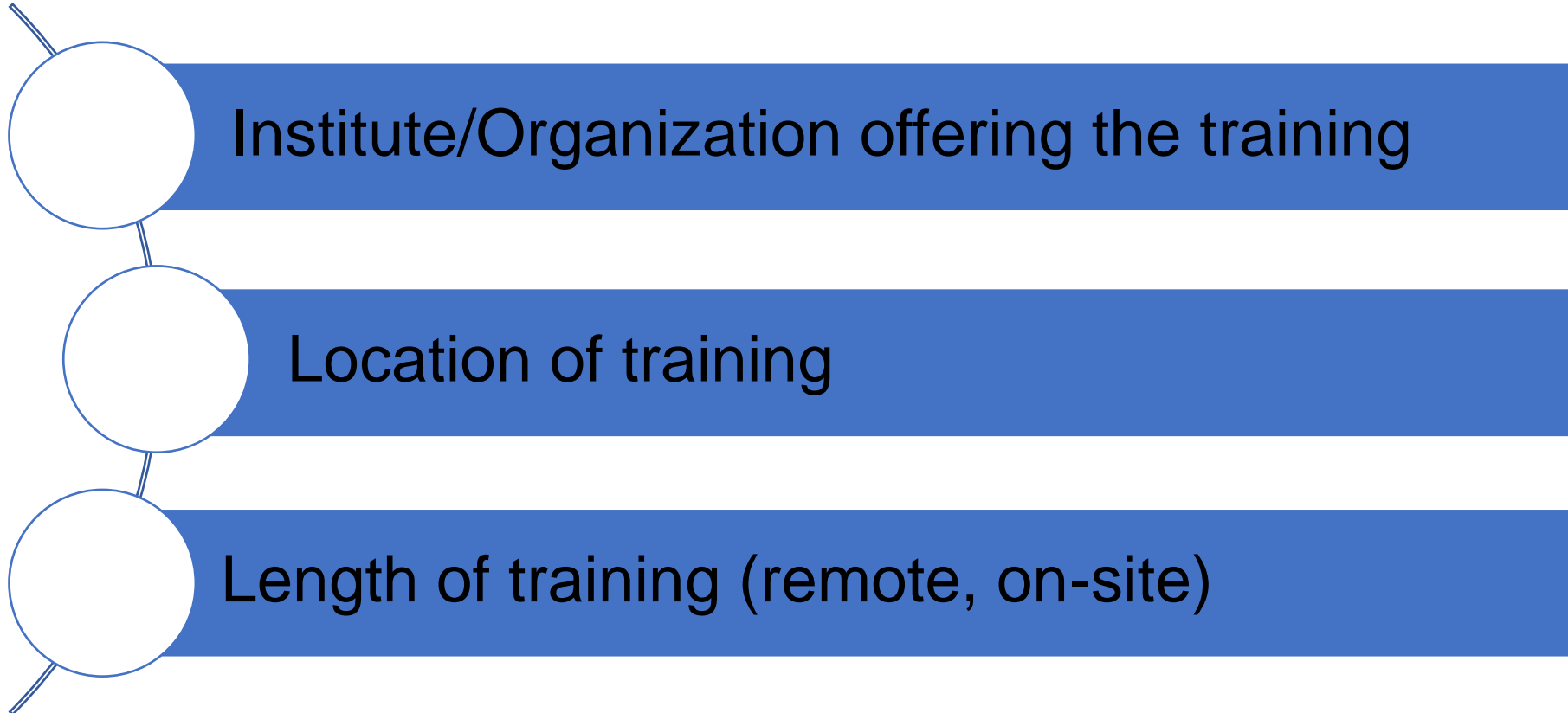
I. Repository of Trainings on Health Security

- Covers training programs related to health security offered by different entities (Universities, Public Health Centers, Research Centers, International Organizations, etc.) in the CAREC region.
- Training programs relevant to core competencies of the International Health Regulations (IHR) (2005) to identify, respond to and control public health threats and potential public health emergencies of international concern (PHEIC).

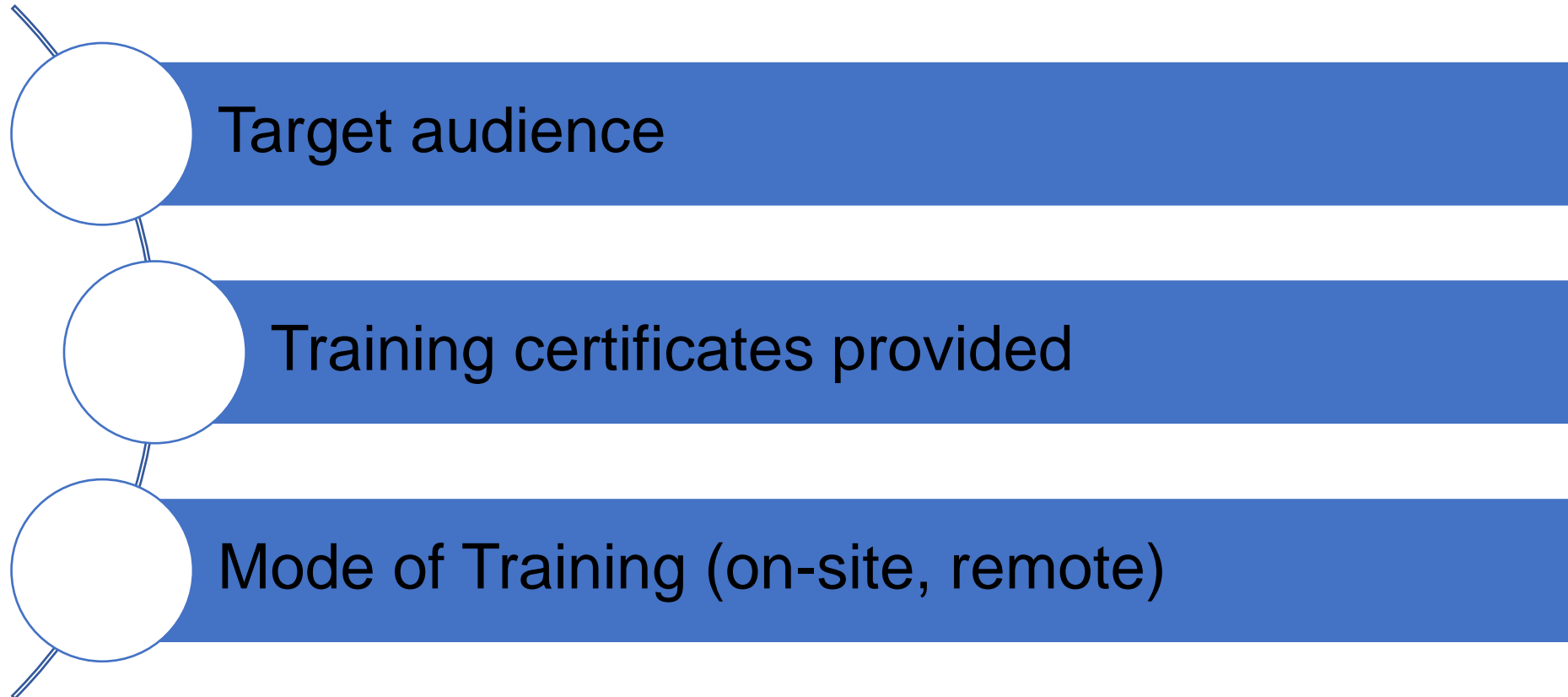

Repository of Trainings on Health Security

Preliminary Results

- Large amount of training programs offered across institutions (and sectors)
- Most training programs in CAREC countries are offered in the local language or Russian; few trainings are offered in English
- In some CAREC countries, training programs are offered by long-standing, well established government-owned organizations or institutes. Accreditation is mostly done by a national body, not by international bodies. International comparability might be limited

Repository of trainings on health security

Preliminary Results

- Some training programs were only offered during the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic, thus, sustainability is not guaranteed
- Hardly any of the training institutes/organizations are aware of an existing repository allowing a comprehensive overview on health security trainings
- Some training programs offered with support from international organizations such as United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (US-CDC), International Organization for Migration (IOM), World Health Organization (WHO) or Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) are not offered in all CAREC countries

Next steps

- Develop this newly created repository into a **regional tool** – managed by the CAREC WGH
- Develop it into a “living” online repository to inform countries, individuals, partners, etc. about available trainings
- Potentially enable user access to training institutions to regularly update their information and promote their trainings
- Consider establishment and feasibility of a **regional center for health security related trainings** – coordinated by the CAREC WGH

II. CAREC Health Cooperation Knowledge Platform

- Interactive health web portal of CAREC under the Cluster Human Development.
- Will contain information on CAREC Health institutional set-up, CAREC Health Strategy 2030 and RIF, knowledge products, upcoming events and financing opportunities in the region.
- Will allow users to click through the four pillars and RIF activities and to upload documents through a protected members area.

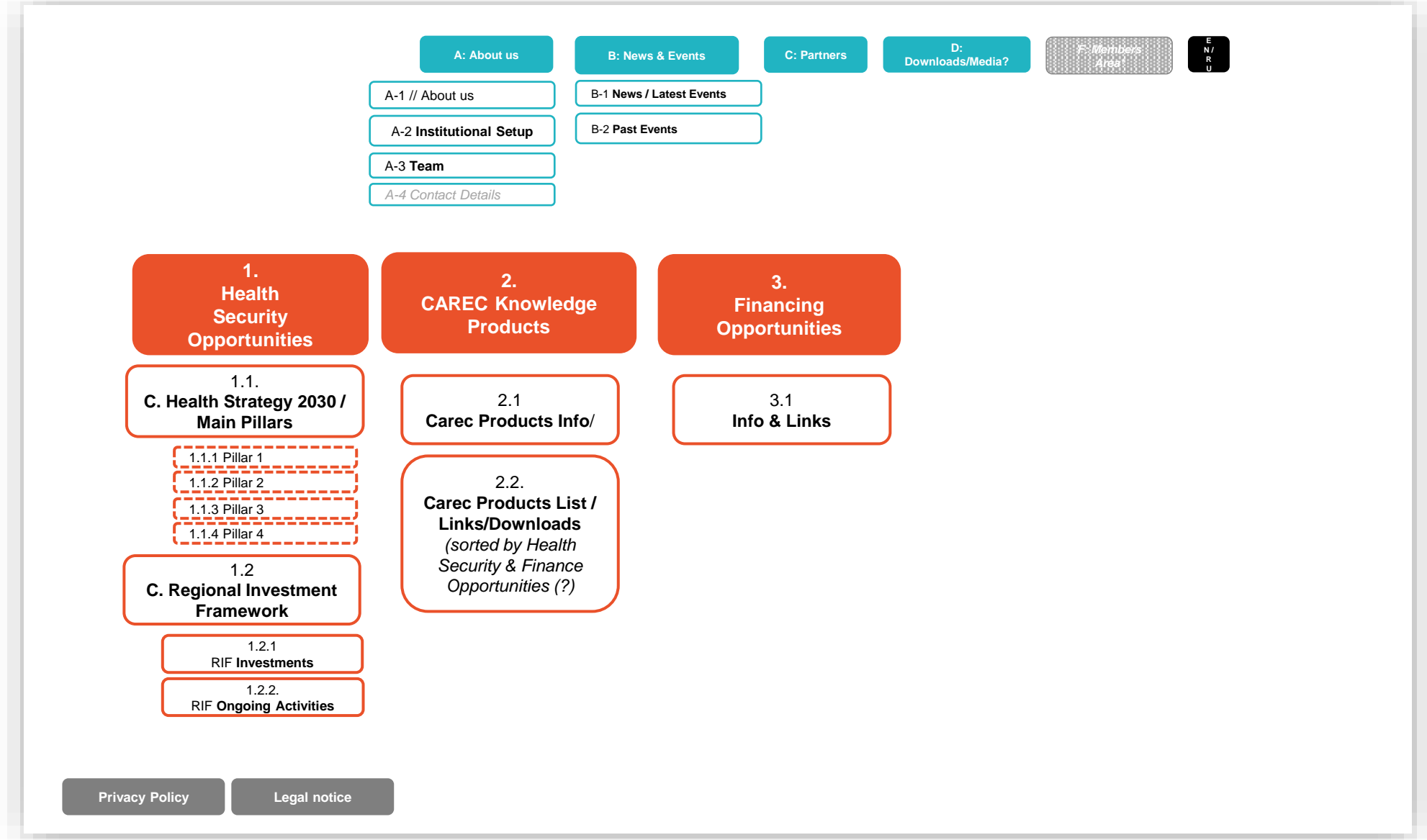

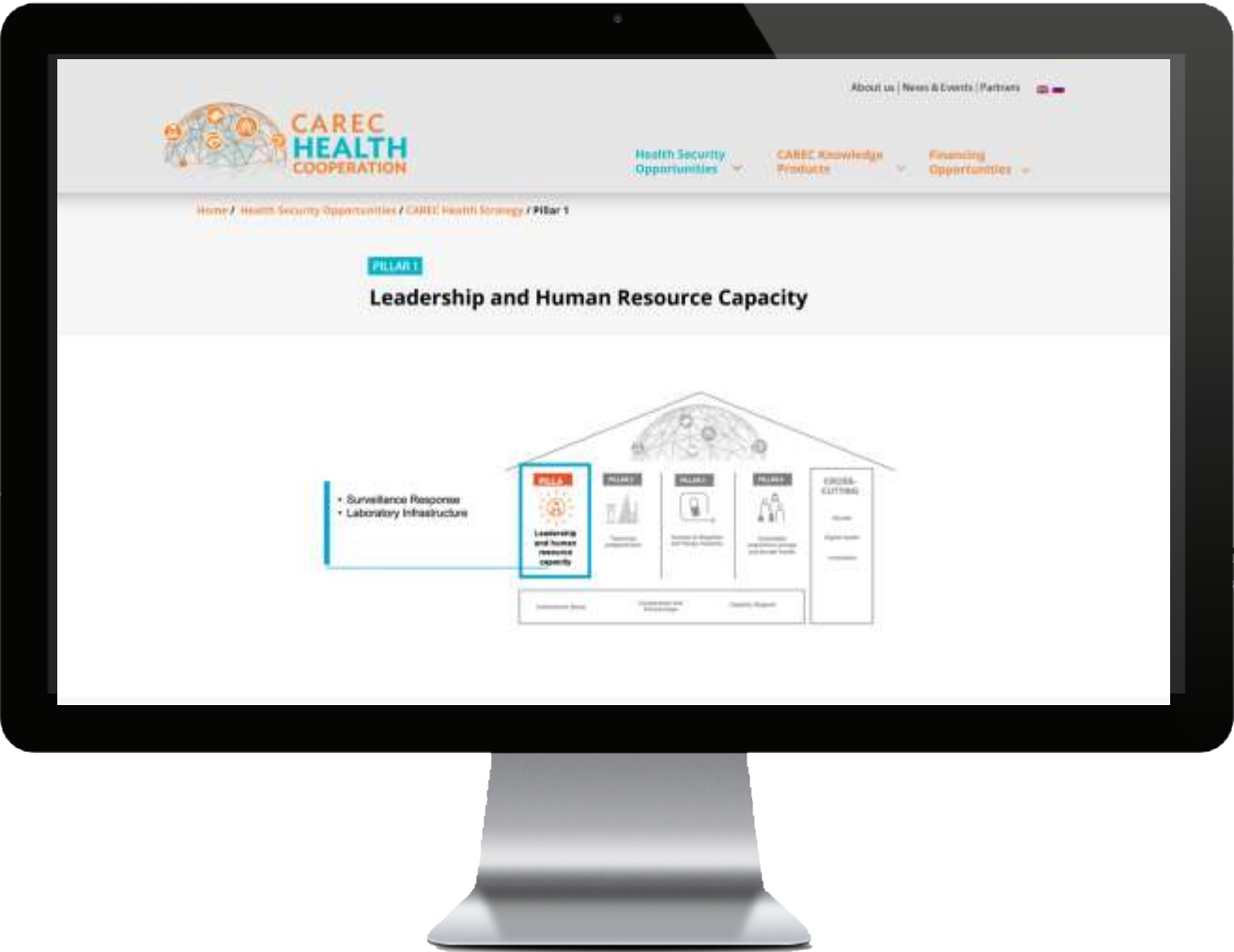
