1. **Contract Formation** A contract will be deemed to have been formed upon confirmation of registration through the Conference Registration Portal.
2. **Registration Terms** Each conference registration is subject to the terms and conditions set out in this prospectus, including those applicable to the Member Ticket Package selected.
3. **Speaking Positions** Acceptance of a registration does not entitle an applicant, or any of its representatives or employees, to preferential consideration for speaking positions at the conference.
4. **Authorised Representatives** Only the President or Executive Director of the Energy & Resources Law Association is authorised to make any binding representation or agreement that varies these terms and conditions. No other representative of the Association has this authority.
5. **Registration & Fees** Registrations must be submitted through the conference website registration portal. The following fees apply to all online registrations:
 - A 2.8% merchant service fee applies to all card types for registrations submitted on or before 31 July 2026. This fee will not apply from 1 August 2026, though additional pricing adjustments may apply under the updated fee structure.
 - A non-refundable \$4.80 processing fee per person applies to all online transactions.By submitting your registration, you confirm your intention to attend the conference and accept liability for any applicable cancellation fees.
6. **Pricing & GST** All prices are quoted in Australian dollars and are inclusive of GST. Accounts are processed via the online portal.
7. **Commencement of Benefits** Delegate benefits will only commence upon receipt of full payment, unless the Energy & Resources Law Association, in its absolute discretion, agrees otherwise.
8. **Registration Categories & Deadlines**
