Report from 2024 and Outcomes

2024 Summer School Report

- 115 participants
- 72% response rate for post event evaluations
- Changes incorporated after evaluations and Industry meeting:
 - Case studies: 4 Open Clinical normal peer review and rubric evaluation
 - 2 Industry Sponsors for 8 minute presentation chosen through normal peer review and rubric evaluation
 - 1 ten minute presentation for Platinum Sponsor with a topic of their choice but approved by AWSA Board
- Change of venue



- Participation in Development of Australian Standards for Health Practitioner Pain Management Education being developed by the Faculty of Pain Medicine Australian and New Zealand College of Anaesthetists. 
