- Advance economic, environmental and social objectives
- Protect the buyers by providing integrity, probity & accountability

QITC Documentation

In November 2017 the Queensland Government replaced GITC contractual documentation with QITC.

- Stakeholder engagement during the planning process

Advantages

- Provides a framework which mitigates risk
- Compliant with procurement legislation
- Templates are preapproved by lawyers
- Prefill standard information specific to your university
- More user friendly
- No supplier GITC certification required





How USQ removed the pain from ICT Procurement?

Created workflows which take requesters through the procurement process addressing compliance along the way

- Intuitive
- User Friendly (information points)
- Configurable

Different workflows for different requests

Simple or complex as required

Workflows for hardware, software, professional services
