The AWSA Board and Faculty invite submissions from registered 2025 Summer School participants to present a case study during the programmed sessions.

Objectives

The goals of the case study presentations are:

- To expand Summer School participants' understanding of the diverse presentations, management options and outcomes for wound and skin conditions
- To develop clinical reasoning skills of Summer School participants
- To promote multidisciplinary collaborative clinical problem solving and discussion
- To build the presentation skills of Summer School participants

Case study topics

For the 2025 Summer School, case studies that have a central focus on the following topics will be considered for selection:

- Inflammation/infection
- Dermatology
- Vascular wounds
- Chronic oedema

Submission and selection

- Case study abstract should be submitted on the template by 10 November 2024
- A maximum of one case study on each of the above topics will be selected based on:
 - Communication and information that builds a clinical story
 - Supportive data (e.g. clinical photos, investigation results, examination findings)
 - Opportunity to engage the Summer School participants in discussion
- Successful presenters will be notified by 24 November 2024
- Successful presenters will be provided with brief guidelines for Power Point slide preparation.
