Major General Walk completed his secondary education at Iona College in Brisbane, he entered the Australian Defence Force Academy in 1989 and graduated from the Royal Military College in 1992. He has served in a variety of regimental and staff appointments at the tactical, operational and strategic level. Command appointments have included, Officer Commanding Joint Movement Control Office – Townsville, Officer Commanding Transport, Company 1st Combat Service Support Battalion and the 7th Combat Service Support Battalion.

Major General Walk has held a range of staff appointments. These have included positions within, Headquarters 3rd Brigade, Headquarters Forces Command as both Military Assistant to Forces Commander, Army Headquarters and the G4

Major General Walk held appointments as Director General Estate Service Delivery and Deputy Commander Joint Logistics, and Commander Joint Logistics. Major General Walk was awarded a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in military history from the University of New South Wales. He has completed a Graduate Diploma in Transport and Distribution Management through Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology. He graduated from the United States Army Command and General Staff College receiving the Eisenhower Award for military scholarship.

In March 1999, Major General Walk deployed to Bosnia Herzegovina on Operation Osier. During this deployment he served as the Staff Officer Grade 3, G4 Operations with Headquarters Multi-National Division – South West. In September 1999, he deployed to East Timor as part of Headquarters 3rd Brigade's contribution to INTERFET.
