Paul Myler is founder and CEO of StratQ, a Perth based advisory firm with a focus on geopolitical risk in the Indo-Pacific and Western Australia's unique role in shaping Australia's national resilience.

He recently returned from 5 years in Washington DC where he was Deputy Chief of Mission at the Australian Embassy. He supported Ambassadors Hockey, Sinodinos and Rudd through major geopolitical and economic shifts including strengthening the Quad and founding of AUKUS; COVID19; China's economic coercion of Australia; prioritisation of trusted supply chains; designing Australia's response to the Biden Administration's Inflation Reduction Act; and the revival of the threat of major power conflict.

A diplomat with over 30 years' experience, Mr Myler was Australia's Ambassador to Russia and the countries of Central Asia from 2013-2015. He collaborated on Russia and Australia's respective G20 host years, and shaped Australia's response to the invasion of Ukraine and downing of Malaysian flight MH17.
