Professor Mazzone is a Professor in Neuroscience at the University of Melbourne. He is the Deputy Head of the Department of Anatomy and Physiology and the Director of the Centre of Research Excellence IMPACT Chronic Cough. Professor Mazzone is a leading authority on the neurobiology of cough and the brain networks governing pulmonary sensory processing. His team is recognized for seminal work in preclinical models describing novel vagal sensory neural circuits arising from the airways and lungs and for translational studies in humans that have provided unprecedented insight into how the human brain processes cough sensory inputs in health and disease.
