Member of Parliament, East Coast Group Representation Constituency (GRC)

Ms Jessica Tan has served as a Member of Parliament for the East Coast Group Representation Constituency (GRC) since 2006 and is currently in her fifth term. She was appointed Chairman of the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) in 2025, marking her second tenure in this role. The PAC reviews Government accounts and ensures the proper use of public funds.

Ms Tan is also the Chairperson of the East Coast Town Council, overseeing the management, maintenance and enhancement of public residential and commercial common areas.

From 2020 to 2025, she served as Deputy Speaker of Parliament. She previously chaired the Public Accounts Committee from 2016 to 2020 and the Government Parliamentary Committee (GPC) for Finance, Trade and Industry from 2010 to 2015. She is currently a member of the Manpower GPC and the Digital Development and Information GPC.

Beyond her parliamentary work, Ms Tan has served on the boards of several Singapore organisations and educational institutions. She currently sits as a non-executive and lead independent director on the board of a Singapore-listed company and non-executive independent director of a global trading and investment company listed in Tokyo.

Ms Tan has more than 27 years of experience in the IT industry, including senior leadership roles at IBM and Microsoft in Singapore and the Asia Pacific region. She also spent five years with Raffles Medical Group as Group Director, Commercial. In 2015, she was named IT Leader of the Year by the Singapore Computer Society.

She holds a Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) degree in Sociology and Economics from the National University of Singapore. She is married with three children and enjoys jogging and cooking in her free time.
