- 1) Research title
- 2) Brief research outline
- 3) Brief background to the research
- 4) Overview of literature review
- 5) Status of ethics approval
- 6) Aims and objectives of the research
- 7) Proposed research methods
- 8) The practical benefits expected to be derived from the research
- 9) Any constraints on publication related to secrecy, security or Intellectual Property
- 10) Why you think PGCS should support this application
- 11) Proposed overall budget and intended use of PGCS funding.

* Notes:

- 1) The sequence of the sections can be varied as needed.
- 2) Submitter's attention is drawn to ensuring that the requirements in the following sections of the **PGCS 2025 Research Proposal** (available online) are addressed:
 - a. Section 1 (Contemporary major project delivery challenges)
 - b. Section 2 (Research aims will be achieved)
 - c. Section 4 (Proposed research questions will be answered)
 - d. Section 4 (Conformance to the recommended research methodology).
- 3) The PGCS Academic Review Committee panel will assess the research proposals submitted against the selection criteria provided in the PGCS 2025 Research Proposal available online.
