

The KidsResus Education and Training Program offers paediatric life support training to those involved in the initial resuscitation of an infant or child in respiratory or cardiac arrest. The program aims to improve the quality and effectiveness of resuscitation during a critical event.

The KidsResus programs are delivered in an interdisciplinary context across all health disciplines including doctors, nurses, paramedics, allied and community health professionals and university students. The KidsResus Coordinators will support you in training local instructors within your organisation.

Program structure

The program is delivered in 2 components:



E-Learning

Explores DRSABCD—with expansion of Exposure, Fluids and Glucose which is uniquely paediatric focused.

This is completed prior to attending the simulation, ensuring participants have the knowledge and skills required to successfully participate in the scenarios.



Simulation (60 minutes)

Human Factors and how these contribute to the outcome of a critical event is a focus of the discussion. Participants are encouraged to participate and reflect on their own experiences. The facilitated simulation scenarios allow the participants to combine the skills and knowledge gained from the e-Learning and respond to an unresponsive patient.
