



## **Shaun Robertson**

Shaun Robertson is currently acting in the role of Nurse Educator at the Gold Coast University Hospital's Emergency Department. In this role he co-leads the Nursing Education Team providing education and training to an emergency department roster of 377 nursing staff. Prior to this he served as a full time Nursing Officer with the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) and now serves as a specialist reservist.

He has attained multiple post graduate qualifications including a Master of Nursing (advanced practice), Master of Traumatology, Post Graduate Certificate of Aeromedical Retrieval, Graduate Certificate in Nursing (emergency) and a Graduate Certificate Disaster Risk Reduction.

He has deployed multiple times overseas in emergency nursing and aeromedical roles including to Afghanistan, on border protection and, disaster and humanitarian operations. He was previously the lead RAAF aeromedical and expeditionary health instructor and the RAAF Health Services Wing Health Operations and Plans Officer (global operations).

Shaun's honours include being awarded a silver level Air Force Commendation for his work co-authoring the RAAF Manual of Aeromedical Evacuation, a United Nations Command commendation for work completed within the multinational coordination centre in the Republic of Korea and being selected as one of Queensland Health's top 25 emerging nurse leaders under the age of 35 in 2020. He is also a 2022 Prince of Wales Award recipient.
