Call for Abstracts

Scientific papers are invited for oral presentations, mini orals and poster presentations. Authors should submit abstracts written in English to Taylored Images no later than 1200 noon Eastern Standard Time (EST) on **Friday 16 April 2021**. Papers received after this date will not be accepted for inclusion in this year's program.
