Humboldt County, California is an extremely rural county of approximately 135,000 residents, including 11 recognized Native American tribes and 7 incorporated cities. Covering 3,568 square miles, the county includes a productive bay and harbor on the Pacific Ocean and stretches east into rugged, sparsely populated coastal mountains. The transportation distances and restrictions isolate Humboldt, resulting in an island-like economy.

Intended Outcomes

- > Reduction in homelessness for families and individuals with a serious mental illness.
- > Decrease in the number of jail bookings.
- > Decrease in the number of hospital and emergency department admissions.
- > Decrease in the number of crisis stabilizations and psychiatric hospitalizations.
- Reduce the number of families in the child welfare system experiencing homelessness.
- > Increase family reunification.
- > Prevent foster care placements.
- > Increase health and wellness and the ability to fully participate in community.
