THE VENUE

The Chicago Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile is the official venue for the IASLC | ASCO 2025 North America Conference on Lung Cancer. All Conference Sessions and meals as well as the Exhibition, Poster Hall, and Symposia will take place at Chicago Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile. HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS



EXHIBIT OPPORTUNITIES

The Exhibit & Poster Hall is located on the 5th floor (same level as Registration and the General Session) in Chicago Ballroom EFGH. ADVISORY BOARD MEETINGS

- Meeting space rental and AV will be an additional cost as determined by the external property.



ANCILLARY EVENTS

Any social or networking event wherein invited participants are professional attendees of the Conference is considered an Ancillary Event. Ancillary Events must be approved by the IASLC, and a fee is required to hold such an event.

Ancillary Events held in conjunction with IASLC | ASCO 2025 North American Conference on Lung Cancer are not allowed to take place during blackout times, which include all scientific sessions, the Faculty Dinner, and the Women in Thoracic Oncology Forum.

Onsite Ancillary Event Fee

The fee for holding an Onsite Ancillary Event in conjunction with NACLC25 is \$5,000. The fee includes event space (space permitting, assigned by IASLC) and the contact list of conference registrants who have given permission to share their details for the purpose of receiving Advisory Board and Ancillary Event invitations.

OFFICE/MEETING SPACE
