

How to prepare print files for large format prints:

- accepted file type standard print pdf
- all print files ideally 1:1
- name the print files to be well identifiable
- all fonts need to be converted into curves
- ideal bitmap resolution is 100-150 DPI in **final size** and in the same time, if possible please keep the individual files sizes smaller than 100MB
- bleeds are always useful, especially with correct cropmarks
- use/send CMYK colour space only

a responsibility note:

- we check sizes and quantities of received print files
- we briefly check fonts (that should have been all converted into curves)
- we briefly visually check bitmap resolutions
- we guarantee that the content of received print files will be printed in maximum quality from the print files that have been received
- none of the above transfers any responsibility for correctness and quality of the content of the received print files onto our company as a supplier

if the print files have not been sent according to the above requirements, it may affect the planned print date and in an extreme case it may result in failure to meet the exposition realisation deadline.
