



Financial support application for junior US scientists to participate in the 2nd North American Photosynthesis Conference (aPS2): (in person only)

Congress: June 3 to June 6, 2024. Urban Life Building, Georgia State University.

The US Department of Energy has generously provided funds to competitively support graduate students, postdocs and early career faculty to participate in the **2**nd **North American Photosynthesis Conference** (see website: https://utconferences.eventsair.com/2nd-north-american-photosynthesis-congress/).

In-person attendance is required for financial support, which will consist of a partial waiver of the registration cost of the meeting, or a contribution toward housing costs.

Eligibility: All graduate students, postdocs and early career faculty working in US labs are eligible to apply.

Application process:

- Please submit a single combined (Abstract + Resume + Recommendation Letter) pdf document:
 - Page 1. The abstract that you will be submitting and presenting at the Congress.
 - Page 2: 2-page resume
 - Page 3 A signed letter of recommendation (1 page) from your advisor or mentor.
- Send the application as a single pdf file to ghastings@gsu.edu
- File name should begin with the applicant's surname. For example, if the applicant's name is Jane Smith, the application **file should be named:** *smith_application.pdf*

Application deadline: May 5 (early applications are encouraged, however).
