He received his Ph.D. in Physics from the Royal Institute of Technology (KTH) in Stockholm in 2004 and his M.Sc. in Nuclear Engineering from the Czech Technical University in Prague in 1996. His technical background includes advanced reactor systems,



related material compatibility and safety assessments, as well as energy system integration in the evolving markets. Prior to his current position, he held research posts at the Nuclear Research Centre in Řež, Czech Republic, KTH, Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT), and the European Commission's Joint Research Centre (JRC).
