Linas had 8 years of experience with JSC „Mazeikiu Nafta“ as Director of Primary Logistics (2008-2009) and as Manager of Petroleum Product Transportation Department (2001-2008).

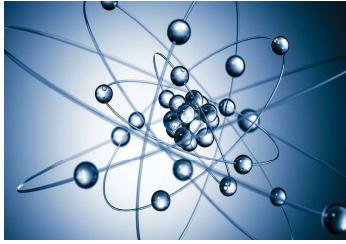
