Mr. Friedman also served in Washington as Special Assistant for Caspian Basin Energy Diplomacy and on the Russia Desk. Prior to joining the Foreign Service, Mr. Friedman was Vice President of a Washington, DC-based telecommunications market consulting firm. Mr. Friedman received an M.S. in National Security Strategy from the National War College in 2009. He also holds a B.A. in Economics from the University of California, Berkeley and an M.A. in International Affairs from Columbia University.
