

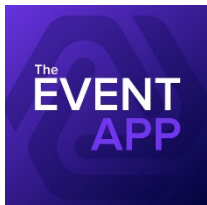


Pre-Event Information

We encourage all attendees to download the **ECSWR 2026 Attendee App** ahead of the conference. The Attendee App serves as a centralized hub for all event-related information that attendees can conveniently access from their mobile devices.

Please note, the ECSWR 2026 attendee app is called **The Event App by EventsAIR** in the app store. The event code for the attendee app is **ecswr2026**

You can do this by accepting the prompt when it appears or by adjusting your notification settings within your mobile device after downloading the app. This will help you stay informed about conference alerts and messages or connections from other attendees.
