ESPO Congress Fellowships

The purpose is to enable a paediatric otolaryngologist from a low-income country, who would otherwise not be able to attend, to participate in an ESPO Congress by awarding a grant of **€1,000** from ESPO central funds towards the costs of travel and hotel accommodation. The Congress registration fee will be waived.

Guidelines

- 1) Applicants must be young paediatric otolaryngologists who have completed their Residency training and are at an early stage in their Consultant career
- 2) Applicants must be from low-income countries:
 - one Fellowship should be awarded to an applicant from Eastern Europe
 - one Fellowship may be awarded to an applicant from a non-European country
- 3) Applicants should not be ESPO Council Members
- 4) Applicants must submit:
 - a. A covering letter explaining why they wish to attend the Congress
 - b. Their CV (no more than 4 sides of A4)
 - c. A letter of support from their Head of Department or the President of their national ENT Society
- 5) A strong CV is not essential:
 - suitable applicants may not have had the opportunity for research etc.
 - the most important thing is their potential for deriving benefit from the Congress
- 6) Successful applicants will be encouraged to submit an abstract for the Congress
- 7) Successful applicants will be expected to submit a short report of their participation in the Congress (no more than one side of A4) with permission to publish it on the ESPO website
