



Invite to HSE Integrated Healthcare Conference 2026: *Delivering Integrated Care Together*

We are inviting patient partners to attend the upcoming HSE Integrated Healthcare Conference 2026 which will focus on the ongoing reform in the health service that directly impacts staff and service users. The conference will highlight patient experience through panel discussions and case studies.

When is the Conference taking place?

Thursday, 3 September 2026. Registration begins from 8.30am; Conference commences at 9.30am.

Where is the Conference taking place?

The Convention Centre Dublin.

Who is the Conference for?

The conference will encompass the full spectrum of health service staff across all services. As users of the health services, patient partners are also invited to attend the conference.

What is the Conference about?

The conference focuses on delivering integrated care including the current changes and impacts across the health service. The conference covers primary, community, and acute care, highlighting the importance of integrated care delivery.

What is the Conference Theme?

The theme of the conference is "Delivering Integrated Care Together."

What topics will be covered at the conference?

Stakeholders from the Health Service Executive, Department of Health and Department of Children, Disability & Equality will deliver a range of speeches and panel discussions. The patient experience will be highlighted throughout the conference, with a particular focus during panel discussions and case studies.

What are the poster presentations?

400 poster presentations will be available to view. Posters were submitted from 10 categories across the wide spectrum of the Health Service. These posters have been submitted by staff across the health system.

Who will be attending the conference?

The conference will be attended by:

- Staff from across the wider health system including primary, community and acute care
- Patient Partners



- Representatives from the Department of Health, Department of Children, Disability & Equality
- HSE Senior Leadership
- Trade Unions, Advocacy Groups and Voluntary Organisations.

What is your role?

We are inviting patient partners to attend the conference which focuses on the delivery of integrated care in the health service. Patient partners will have the opportunity to actively engage and provide valuable feedback.

- Patient partners can select breakout sessions most relevant to them.
- During panel discussions, there will be an opportunity to ask questions.
- Breaks will offer further opportunities to view poster presentations and network with staff and fellow patient partners.
- Following the conference a survey will be provided to all conference attendees. This will provide an opportunity to provide feedback on your experience.

What costs are associated?

The conference is free to attend. Meals and refreshments will be provided. Patient partners will be reimbursed for any out-of-pocket expenses in line with the Policy for Reimbursement of Expenses for Service Users Participating in the Design, Delivery and Development of Services in the HSE by the Integrated Healthcare Conference organizing team.
