Davide Faggionato obtained his master's degree in biotechnology from the University of Padua in Italy and his PhD in molecular genetics from the University of Freiburg in Germany. After two postdoctoral positions in molecular evolution in the United States, he returned to Germany where he worked in laboratory management and project management in Hanover at the Helmholtz Center for Infection Research and at the Medical University of Hanover.

Since 2022, he has been working on science policy and access and benefit-sharing compliance at the Department of Science Policy and Internationalization at the Leibniz Institute DSMZ (German Collection of Microorganisms and Cell Cultures GmbH) in Braunschweig which host and operates the German Nagoya Protocol HuB.
