



General terms and conditions for the delegates of the Underground Construction Conference Prague 2026

1. Introductory Provisions

- 1.1. These General Terms and Conditions govern the legal relations between the organizer of the Underground Construction Conference 2026 (hereinafter referred to as the “Event”) and the participants of the Event.
- 1.2. The organizer of the Event is **AIM Group Prague, s.r.o.**, Panská 7/890, Prague 1, 110 00, Czech Republic.
- 1.3. A participant is understood to mean a holder of registration in all categories, including partners, exhibitors, speakers, guests, and members of the media.

2. Validity of the General Terms and Conditions

- 2.1. Upon entering the venue of the Event, participants are subject to:
 - I. The General Terms and Conditions set forth herein.
 - II. The Visitor Regulations of the Event venue.
 - III. Any other documents and regulations agreed upon with the Organizer.
- 2.2. These General Terms and Conditions become valid upon the purchase of a registration or by any other means of gaining entry, or by entering the Event venue itself, at which moment the participant expresses their consent to these Terms and Conditions.

3. Registration

- 3.1. All people interested in attending the Underground Construction Conference 2026 in Prague must register via the online registration form available on the conference website [here](#).
- 3.2. Depending on the type of participation, individual registrations include the following items:

Delegate registration fee includes:

- admission to the scientific programme of the conference including a poster section and exhibition
- conference materials including electronic conference proceedings
- admission to the Social Evening
- participation in the technical excursion
- coffee breaks and lunches (25 and 26 May 2026)

Student registration fee includes:

- admission to the scientific programme of the conference including a poster section and exhibition



- electronic conference proceedings
- participation in the technical excursion
- coffee breaks (25 and 26 May 2026)

The registration fee for Accompanying person includes:

- admission to the Opening Ceremony
- participation in the Social Evening
- optional accompanying program (25 and 26 May 2026)

3.3. All amounts are payable in Euro (EUR) without bank charges.

3.4. When registering, the participant selects a method of payment:

- Payment by card
 - Please make sure to complete your registration in one session, including payment. All online payments are processed via a secure connection through the Stripe payment gateway.
- Payment by bank transfer
 - When making a bank transfer, please always include the participant's full name and invoice number (last 3 digits) in the payment details. Payment by bank transfer is possible until **10 May 2026**. After this date, all payments can only be made by credit or debit card.

The registration fee must be paid in advance to the account specified by the organizer.

3.5. The registration fee must be paid by the deadline corresponding to the selected registration type. If payment is not credited to the organizer's account by the deadline, the higher (later) fee will be charged automatically. An unpaid or only partially paid registration will not be considered valid until it has been paid in full.

3.6. Online registration will close on **22 May 2026**. From **24 May 2026**, on-site registration will be available at the congress venue.

3.7. After completing the online registration form, each participant will receive an email confirmation of registration together with the final invoice.



- 3.8. For payments made by bank transfer, the participant will receive confirmation of payment once the amount has been credited to the designated account.
- 3.9. The registration fee does not include participant insurance. Participants are advised to arrange appropriate personal insurance.
- 3.10. Group registrations cannot be processed online under a single email address. Each participant must have their own profile with a unique email address. For the registration of multiple persons under one company identity/invoice, please contact the Secretariat at PS2026.reg@aimgroup.eu.

4. Payment and cancellation conditions

4.1. Registration

Cancellation policy:

- Until 31 March 2026 - No cancellation fee; a handling charge of 20 EUR applies.
- From 1 April to 30 April 2026 - 50% of the registration fee will be refunded.
- From 1 May 2026 onwards - No refunds will be issued.

4.3. The cancellation date is defined as the day on which the organizer receives the cancellation of the order.

Other:

- in case of no-show you will be charged the full amount
- a name change (no later than 30 April 2026) will be charged at 10 EUR
- the final invoice will be issued based on the information provided during registration. Any changes to this information (address, VAT number, etc.) are only possible within 3 days of the registration date and are subject to a handling fee of 10 EUR
- in case the event is cancelled due to force majeure, AIM Group Prague reserves the right to charge a handling fee of 7 EUR

5. Participation in the Event

Visitors to the venue are required to respect generally accepted rules of proper conduct and good manners during their stay, i.e., primarily politeness and consideration, and must refrain from any acts of interpersonal, racial, religious, or political intolerance.

Visitors are required not to disturb the lecture sessions by their behavior, to act considerately towards other participants, and, in case of emergencies, to follow the instructions of the organizer, the venue operator, and the relevant emergency services.



6. Recording and Personal Data Protection

By participating in the congress, you confirm that all personal data you provide, or data legitimately received by third parties, will be used in connection with your participation in the congress and/or for the purpose of providing information about other compatible activities organized by us or any other company affiliated with the group (“AIM Group”), of which AIM Group Prague s.r.o. is a part, including those located in other European countries.

Your likeness, captured during the Event, may be reproduced in videos and photographs from the Event and published on AIM Group websites and social media (and on the Event’s website and social media, if applicable).

For the avoidance of doubt, a third party for whom the conference is organized has the same rights as the AIM Group under this notice.

Providing personal data, including consent to the taking and use of photographic or video recordings, is necessary for your participation in the congress. Refusal to provide this information will unfortunately make your registration and participation impossible. Consent to receive information about other activities or educational programs organized by the AIM group is voluntary; however, if you do not give this consent, you will not be informed about future events.
