Tour To Aquila Game Reserve

This is a fantastic safari experience a convenient 2 hour drive from Cape Town. We will drive on the N1 Highway, through the incredible Hex River Valley and arrive at the Aquila Private Game Reserve. A well informed ranger will lead you on a game drive showcasing a diverse environment of Giraffe, Blesbok, Black and Blue Wildebeest, Zebra, Springbok, Gemsbok Klipspringers, Duiker, Greybuck, Steenbok, Ostriches, Baboons, Caracal, Foxes, Jackal, Leopard as well as 172 species of birds, including the Black Eagle, are found on the reserve.

Before we depart we will enjoy a hearty lunch at the lodge.

Return transfer to the city and overnight.

Day 3

City & Table Mountain & Township Experience

Pick up from your hotel at 09h00. The drive through the city centre takes you past famous landmarks such as the Castle of Good Hope built in 1666 by the Dutch East India Company and the Cape Town City Hall, a baroque building and the Grand Parade. As we follow the city's main thoroughfare onto Adderley Street, we will see St. George's Cathedral, the Anglican Diocese of Nobel Peace Laureate Archbishop Desmond Tutu. The tour passes the Company Gardens and the Malay Quarter [also known as the Bo-Kaap] which means "Above Cape" because of its location up against the slopes of Table Mountain. In the early 18th century, thousands of slaves from Java, Ceylon and other Far Eastern regions were brought to Cape Town. After slavery was abolished, their descendants, known as the Cape Malay's, settled here.

Continuing to Table Mountain, where you can ascend to the top [weather permitting] by the revolving cable car. Here, you'll see wild flowers and the famous silver tree, and marvel at a birds-eye view of the city and its beaches. On a clear day it is even possible to see Robben Island where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned on one side and on the other side Cape Point is visible. The tour then continues along the N2 passing some of the oldest Townships in Cape Town onto Khayelitsha for a 4Roomed eKasi Culture experience, which is a lifestyle concept based on the four roomed homes found in the oldest townships of South Africa. A life celebrated through great food, beautiful home decor & art, and the most inconceivable lifestyle ideas evoking a sense of nostalgia while promoting an inclusive hub for all who live and visit South Africa!

Return transfer to the city and overnight.

Cape of Goodhope

Named the 'Cape of Storms' by Bartolomeu Dias in 1488; the 'Point' was treated with respect by sailors for centuries. By day, it was a navigational landmark and by night, and in fog, it was a menace beset by violent storms and dangerous rocks that over the centuries littered shipwrecks around the coastline.

Penguin Colony

Once through the turnstiles, one can stake your claim on the pristine sand and then freely explore the large 540 million year-old granite boulders, small rock pools and little bays in close proximity of the flightless little swimming birds.
