## Summary

The Planetary Society has 2 international grant programs relevant to planetary defense:

- Gene Shoemaker NEO Grants
  - planetary.org/neogrants
- Science and Technology Empowered by the Public (STEP) Grants
  - planetary.org/stepgrants

### **Shoemaker NEO Grants**

- International grants for amateur and underfunded professionals primarily for telescope upgrades to facilitate asteroid characterization and follow-up
- The program is named for pioneering planetary geologist Gene Shoemaker.
- Grant winners have made many significant contributions to asteroid discovery, tracking, and characterization.
- New round of awardees to be announced in June.

# Over the 25 year history of the program: approximately \$515,000 has been granted to 70 winners in 21 countries on 6 continents.

## Planetary Society STEP Grants

- A newer much broader science and technology grant program:
- The Planetary Society STEP (Science and Technology Empowered by the Public) Grants
  - planetary science and/or technology grants
  - open, international, competed proposal process

#### The TPS STEP Grants

- Current anticipated grant sizes of ~US\$50,000.
- Calls for proposals nominally every 2 years (initially have been more frequent).
- 2 step process: open call for pre-proposals, followed by invited full proposals.
- New round of awardees to be announced shortly.

### The STEP Grants

- Topics must fit within one or more TPS Core Enterprises:
  - Explore Worlds: Increase discoveries about the worlds of our solar system and beyond.
  - Find Life: Elevate the search for life as a space exploration priority.
  - Defend Earth\*: Decrease the risk of Earth being hit by an asteroid or comet.

<sup>\*</sup>One of the first two awards was for NEO research

## The STEP Grants (cont.)

#### STEP Grants seek:

- Credible/significant research and hardware development projects.
- Projects needing seed funding or that can leverage other funding.
- Projects that will generate public interest and support.
- Investigators willing to assist in crowdfunding efforts.
- Investigators willing to provide regular updates to the public.
- Note: projects that fit as Shoemaker NEO Grant proposals are not eligible for STEP Grants
