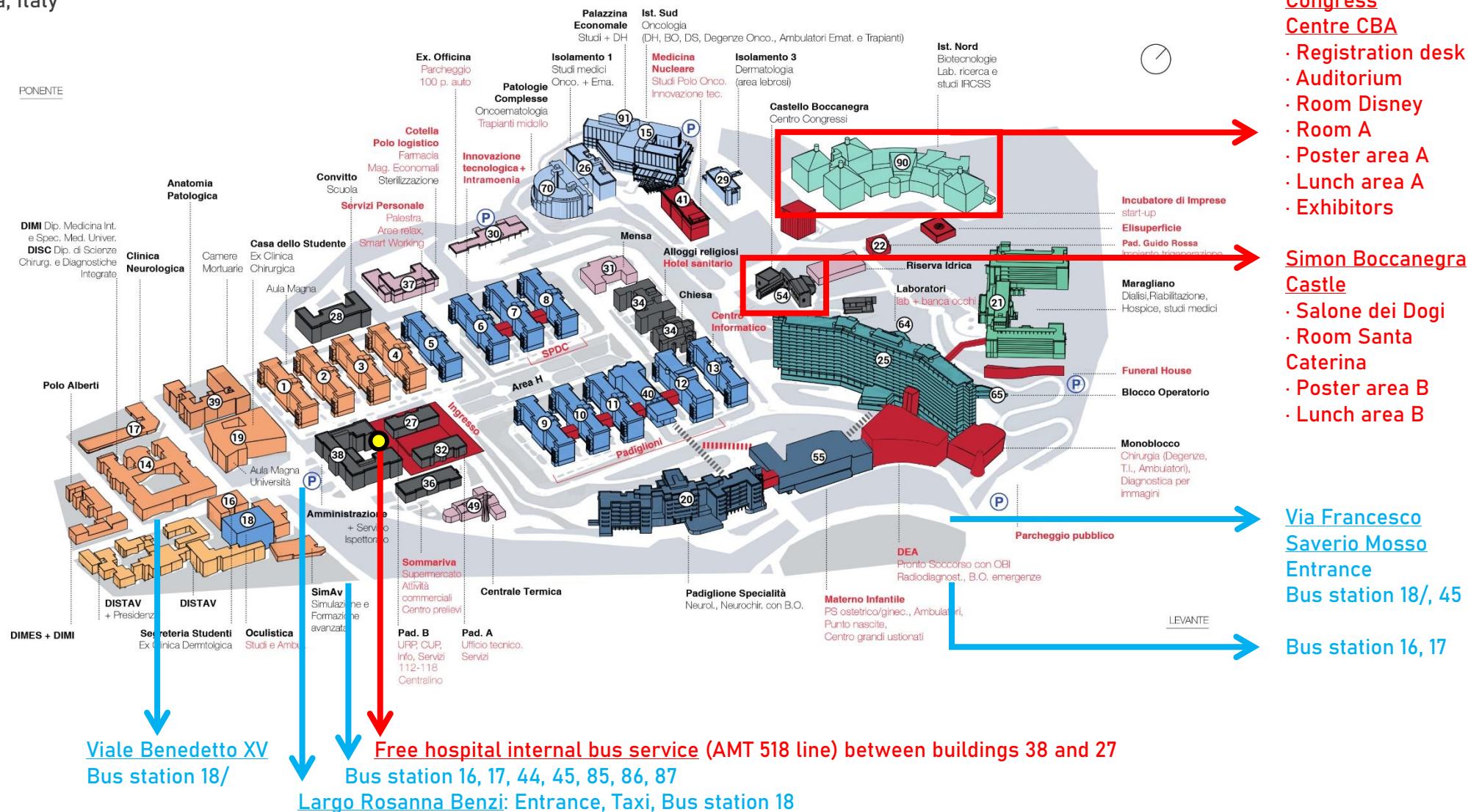

HOW TO REACH THE CONFERENCE VENUES (CBA AND CASTELLO SIMON BOCCANEGRA)

Within the hospital walls there is a free public transport service, Bus AMT 518 line, with the terminus in front of the Palazzo dell' Amministrazione, internal side. To reach both the CBA and the Castello Simon Boccanegra, we recommend getting off at the IST Nord-Centro Congressi stop, from which the conference venues can be reached on foot in a few minutes. The conference venues can also be reached by your own vehicle. Parking is subject to charges.

HOW TO ARRIVE TO THE SAN MARTINO POLYCLINIC HOSPITAL IN GENOA:

BUS

The main entrance of the hospital complex can be reached by the following public transport: AMT lines 16, 17, 18, 18/, 44, 45, 85, 86 and 87.

The most recommended ones are the AMT lines 16 and 17.

The AMT lines 16, 17, 18/ and 45 stop in Via Francesco Saverio Mosso where you can also get into the hospital complex.

CAR

Car access to the hospital is regulated and parking is permitted only in designated parking areas. There are approximately 330 paid parking spaces available , in addition to approximately 110 free parking spaces, reserved for:

- disabled people (approximately 90 places)
- dialysis patients (10 places)
- blood donors (10 places)

To benefit from free parking, those entitled to it must collect the ticket upon entry to the hospital and show, upon exit at the Monoblocco driveway door only, the only one manned by dedicated personnel, the disabled person's permit or the certification proving the health service provided. Parking and transit are free for the first 30 minutes, after which the following rates apply:

- From 1st to 4th hour: €1.50/h
- From the 5th to the 12th hour: €7 total

We strongly recommend the use of public transport specially in the morning, however, if you decide to use your private car the best option is the San Martino Parking (managed by Saba Italia) situated in Largo Rosanna Benzi, adjacent to the hospital. The parking lot has 421 covered parking spaces. For more information please visit: www.sabait.it
