
About ICIAM

The International Council for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (ICIAM) is a worldwide organization for professional applied mathematics societies, and for other societies with a significant interest in industrial or applied mathematics. Currently, ICIAM has 54 member societies worldwide. The first Congress took place in Paris in 1987. Since then, congresses take place every four years, so far having been held in Washington, Hamburg, Edinburgh, Sydney, Zurich, Vancouver, Beijing, Valencia and most recently in Tokyo. The last one attracted more than 5500 delegates. The next congress will be held in The Hague in 2027.

ICIAM is registered as a charitable organization in the USA. Its main objectives are:

- to promote industrial and applied mathematics internationally;
- to promote interactions between the member societies;
- to promote the goals of these member societies;
- to coordinate planning for periodic international meetings on industrial and applied mathematics.

ICIAM was created in response to the strong development of applied mathematics in the 1970s and 1980s. It was formally established in 1987 by the four societies GAMM, IMA, SIAM, and SMAI. The main activity is the ICIAM Congress which is held every 4 years. The ICIAM congress has already been held in 10 major cities in the world.






ICIAM scientific prizes

lajor scientific prizes ICIAM awards numerous major scientific prizes, and these awards are presented to the recipients during the congress.

ICIAM awards six major scientific prizes at the opening of the ICIAM Congresses:

- ICIAM Collatz Prize to provide international recognition to individual scientists under 42 years of age for outstanding work on industrial and applied mathematics.
- ICIAM Industry Prize to provide international recognition to scientists who have made outstanding contributions to innovative mathematical techniques with demonstrated impact in Industry.
- ICIAM Lagrange Prize to provide international recognition to individual mathematicians who have made an exceptional contribution to applied mathematics throughout their careers.
- ICIAM Maxwell Prize to provide international recognition to a mathematician who has demonstrated originality in applied mathematics.
- ICIAM Pioneer Prize for pioneering work introducing applied mathematical methods and scientific computing techniques to an industrial problem area or a new scientific field of applications.
- ICIAM Su Buchin Prize to provide international recognition of an outstanding contribution by an individual in the application of mathematics to emerging economies and human development, in particular at the economic and cultural level in developing countries.





- ICIAM is a scientific partner of the Centre International de Mathématiques Pures et Appliquées (CIMPA) which co-organises and sponsors numerous activities in developing countries, in all continents.
- ICIAM provides support for attendance at conferences in/from developing countries.
- ICIAM is a category 1 full member of the International Science Council (ISC).
