



# Privacy Policy

## **Membership Privacy Notice**

The BioMedEng Association is committed to protecting the personal data of its members and processes information in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018. Personal data provided as part of membership is used to administer membership, communicate with members about Association activities, and support the delivery and promotion of events, including the annual conference. For the purposes of organising and promoting the annual conference, the Association may share limited member contact details with selected third-party partners involved in conference delivery or sponsorship. Any such sharing is restricted to what is necessary, carried out under appropriate data protection safeguards, and the data is not sold or used for unrelated purposes. Processing is undertaken on the basis of legitimate interests and, where required, consent. Members have the right to access, correct, or request deletion of their personal data, to object to certain processing activities, and to withdraw consent at any time by contacting the Association.

## **Conference Delegate Privacy Notice**

BioMedEng Association collects and processes personal data from conference delegates for the purposes of administering registration, managing attendance, communicating essential event-related information, and supporting the effective delivery of the conference. Personal data may also be used to evaluate, review, and improve future events and related activities. To deliver the conference, the organisers may share limited personal data with third parties who are directly involved in the organisation and operation of the event, such as event management providers, venue operators, technology or registration platform providers, and sponsors or partners where relevant. Any such third-party processing is carried out under appropriate contractual and data protection safeguards and is limited to what is necessary for conference delivery. Personal data will not be sold or used by third parties for unrelated purposes. As part of a reciprocal arrangement, personal data provided during conference registration may also be shared with the Association for the purposes of communicating information about future events, activities, and membership opportunities. Processing is undertaken in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018, relying on contractual necessity, legitimate interests, and consent where applicable. Delegates have the right to access, correct, or request the deletion of their personal data, to object to certain processing activities, and to opt out of future communications at any time.
