

COASTAL DYNAMICS AND WETLAND ECOLOGY OF ST LUCIA AND HLUHLUWE

Explore the rich biodiversity of the area, home to over 500 bird species and wildlife such as crocodiles, hippos. A day excursion to the nearby Hluhluwe-Umfolozi Game Reserve, known for its diverse geology and topography. Enjoy an open vehicle safari that will offer incredible views and wildlife encounters, including the African Big 5, cheetahs, and wild dogs, making for an unforgettable experience. This tour would not be complete without a Zulu Cultural experience at Zulu Nyala Heritage and Safari Lodge where the residents live and practice Zulu traditions as their ancestors did hundreds of years ago. Experience traditional Zulu Beer, Spear making, a traditional healer the Sangoma and so much more. Two game drives 3 hour game drives a day included over and above the full day in Hluhluwe are included.

This tour combines the natural beauty and cultural heritage of the Drakensberg Mountains with thrilling adventures and historical insights. Begin by exploring the Drakensberg, Africa's highest mountain range, home to ancient San-Bushman rock art and diverse Flora and Fauna at Giants Castle. On day two, embark on an exhilarating 4x4 journey up Sani Pass into Lesotho, visiting a Basotho village and enjoying lunch at the Highest Pub in Africa. Day three, Enjoy the day at leisure in this scenic majestic mountain range or perhaps enjoy a small hike to explore the geology of this region. The last day, travel through the KwaZulu-Natal Midlands to visit the Nelson Mandela Capture Site, followed by a stop at the Howick Falls, steeped in local legend. This tour begins with a pickup from O.R. Tambo Airport in Johannesburg, followed by a scenic drive to a game lodge near the Kruger Park. Enjoy a 4-hour Sunset Drive in an open Landcruiser, spotting wildlife and witnessing the African sunset, before a bush BBQ dinner and a night drive. Stay overnight in a in suite airconditioned chalets. The next day, embark on a 4-hour Bush Walk at Olifants River, followed by brunch at a local lodge nearby and an afternoon game drive after which you will return to your lodge. On day 3 enjoy a full day of game viewing and birdwatching in Kruger Park before returning to lodge for leisure time and dinner. The tour concludes with a morning walk, breakfast, and a scenic drive along the Panorama Route, including a visit to Blyde River Canyon and the Three Rondawels, before late afternoon drop off at OR Tambo Airport in Johannesburg.
