● ● SOWETO – ST 1

Duration: 3 Hours

Departure: Daily at 08h00 and 13h00

This is an interesting cultural tour that also covers important recent history. Visit the city with nine diverse ethnic groupings. Touch the soil of the original house of the former President – Nelson Mandela. See and hear the fascinating facts about the first victim of the 1976 students' uprisings. Indulge in the extremely exclusive vibe exuded by the Sowetans.



● ● SOWETO AND JOHANNESBURG – ST2

Duration: 7 Hours

Departure: Daily at 08h00

This tour gives you a real insight into the City of Johannesburg and the sprawling City of Soweto to the South. Ascend to the 50th floor of the Top of Africa and view the surrounding metropolis. Cruise in the busy streets of Johannesburg and see the mining houses. Feel the real ambiance of the heart of Africa and its beautiful people.



● ● PRETORIA CITY – ST3

Duration: 3 Hours

Departure: Daily at 08h00 and 13h00

This tour gives you an insight into the past and future of South Africa. View the administrative capital of South Africa. See the President's residence, the Voortrekker Monument, the Union Buildings and smell the beautiful flowers of the Jacaranda. Get a better understanding of the history of South Africa.



● ● LESEDI CULTURAL VILLAGE - ST5

Duration: 4 Hours

Departure: Daily at 10h00 and 15h00

South Africa has many cultures this tour gives you an opportunity to understand some of them. Visit the Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi and Sotho traditional houses and hear about various South African cultures before sitting down to a traditional dinner. ● ● SUN CITY, THE LOST CITY, PILANESBERG GAME RESERVE – ST6

Duration: 8 Hours

Departure: Daily 08h00

This tour is for Safari and Seeing the Lost City of Sun City. Travel through the Magaliesberg Mountains and feel the breeze of the agricultural land whilst viewing the traditional huts. Observe the shafts of platinum mines before transcending to the Las Vegas of Africa; Sun City – Africa's largest entertainment centre. After experiencing the glittery atmosphere, enter Pilanesberg National Park and have a chance of spotting the "Big Five" animals.



● ● DE WILDT CHEETAH RESEARCH CENTRE – ST7

Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday

Departure: 08h00 and 11h00

This is tour to understand important wildlife. Travel towards Hartbeespoort Dam and arrive during the feeding time of Cheetahs and Cape Hunting Dogs. See the Cape Hunting Dogs at close proximity. Get the chance to see Cape Vultures.



● ● CULLINAN DIAMOND MINE – ST10

Duration: 3½ Hours

Departure: Daily at 09h00

Mining is an important part of South Africa's history and economy. Cullinan is an important Mining town. View a video of underground mining before visiting the mineshaft. Visit the Premier Mine where the biggest diamond was found and learn the history of this mine.

● ● ELEPHANT SANCTUARY – ST12

Duration: 3 Hours

Departure: 09h00 and 12h30

Elephants are the biggest of the Big Five animals in the wild.

Meet and touch the elephants during an exciting, educationally orientated programme. This programme is conducted by experienced guider who will impart a wealth of knowledge to you about elephants.



● ● APARTHEID MUSEUM – ST14

Duration: 2½ Hours

Apartheid is a part of history in South Africa which has shaped the present. This is a never-to-be-missed and moving experience. Experience the history of the old South Africa in this unique museum. Here you will be able to understand the recent history of South Africa.



● ● BUSH SAFARIS

This is the traveler's chance to see untamed Africa, while still enjoying the luxury and comfort offered by a selection of exclusive game reserves. All offer excellent accommodation, superb cuisine, personalized attention, and the excitement of game viewing from open safari vehicles under the care of qualified rangers.

A typical three-day visit to the Bushveld will depart from Johannesburg or Cape Town flight into the heart of the Mpumalanga Province. You will be collected and transferred to your lodge of choice in time to freshen up for lunch or tea.

Explore your camp and prepare for your first afternoon/evening game drive followed by dinner in the open air boma under a dazzling starry sky. The next morning starts with an early morning game drive and a hearty breakfast. Time to relax round the pool or go on a walking trail in the bush with your ranger. Lunch, some more time to relax and then another late afternoon game drive.

Next morning, if time permits, your final game drive, breakfast and then transfer to the airport for your flight to Johannesburg.

There are a number of lodges that we have chosen for delegates, but options are not limited to these suggestions. We have also included lodges in other provinces (Eastern Cape and North West Province).

● ● SABI SANDS, TIMBAVATI IN THE KRUGER NATIONAL PARK AREA

● ● IDUBE LODGE, SABI SANDS GAME RESERVE (M) 2 NIGHTS 3 DAYS EX SKUKUZA AIRPORT

A stay at Idube combines the peace and tranquility of the unspoilt bush with the comfort of a luxury lodge at an affordable price. Ten spacious private chalets accommodate 20 guests and feature en-suite bathrooms, outside showers, air-conditioning, overhead fans and have excellent views of the surrounding bush. Idube Private Game Reserve is home to the Big Five with frequent sightings of cheetah, leopard, and the elusive wild dog. The experienced and trained rangers and expert Shangaan trackers are on hand to introduce you to the wonders of the African bush. While enjoying the beautiful bush sunset, sundowners are served from the Land over and then spotting lights are turned on and the night drive begins.



● ● LION SANDS: TINGA LODGE (M) 2 NIGHTS 3 DAYS FLY IN EX SKUKUZA AIRPORT (KMI)

Lion Sands, Tinga Lodge, is a safari lodge in the Kruger National Park and is built around a 200-year-old Jackalberry tree. The old-world luxury lodge offers a comfortable colonial-style retreat and a welcoming family-friendly atmosphere. Go on game drives and walks around the reserve, where you will have the opportunity to view the Big 5. All the Suites have been positioned to overlook the Sabie River, affording great views of the river and its surroundings. Suites are designed drawing inspiration from African colonial style, with en-suite bathrooms and spacious private lounges. Relax on your private deck and take a swim in the heated plunge pool, while you watch the wildlife that come to the river to quench their thirst.



● ● KAPAMA RIVER LODGE, TIMBAVATI GAME RESERVE - (M) 2 NIGHT 3 DAY FLY IN EX HOEDSPRUIT

The largest of the Kapama Private Game Reserve camps is River Lodge. It's wide, open spaces and airy design are a constant reminder that you are sleeping under the African sky. Besides the luxury five-star accommodation, River Lodge is more festive and social than there smaller, quieter camps, which is why young couples and groups of friends are often among their guests. This is a great game experience with the Big Five often spotted.



● ● TANDA TULA SAFARI CAMP, TIMBAVATI (M) 2 NIGHT 3 DAYS EX HOEDSPRUIT AIRPORT

The extraordinarily beautiful newly refurbished Safari Camp sits in the exact same location, but it is more ecologically sensitive and has a lighter footprint. In embracing change, Tanda Tula have evolved into a light-filled and transparent design that merges seamlessly with the wilderness around you. Each suite is positioned so that all the interior and outdoor spaces have uninterrupted views across the riverbed. Located in the Timbavati Private Nature Reserve within the Greater Kruger National Park. 7 Safari Suites for 2 guests and 2 Family Suites for 4 guests each (2 adults and 2 children or 2 couples).

The spacious suites have an open plan lounge and bedroom configuration leading onto an expansive terrace with your own private plunge pool overlooking the dry riverbed. The bathroom offers indoor and outdoor showers, freestanding bathtub, and all other amenities. Each suite is light and airy. The main areas consisting of lounge, dining, and bar areas with a wraparound, covered patio, communal pool, as well as library, Exercise Zone, and Wellness Nest.

Game drive policy at Safari Camp is a maximum of 6 guests per vehicle (shared). Private vehicles must be booked in advance at an additional cost and depend on availability.

We accept children between the ages of 6 and 16. 17 years and older is considered an adult.

● ● GARDEN ROUTE

● ● GARDEN ROUTE TOUR CAPE TOWN TO PORT ELIZABETH 5 NIGHTS, 6 DAYS

DAY 1: Monday - Cape Town - Cape Agulhas - Mossel Bay

This morning you will be met by your local tour guide and depart for the scenic Garden Route. Travel along Sir Lowry's Pass, with its magnificent views, to Grabouw and Elgin, a lush landscape surrounded by majestic mountains. Stop en route at a farmstall packed with locally produced products from the area. Our journey continues to Cape Agulhas, the southernmost tip of Africa, where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. The area has largely been untouched and unexplored with its rugged coastline being the graveyard for many a ship. The historic Cape Agulhas Lighthouse is considered the icon that signifies the tip of Africa. After this thrilling experience, we continue via historic Swellendam, the third oldest town in South Africa, to Mossel Bay, from where the Garden Route extends to the Storms River in the east. Overnight in Mossel Bay.

DAY 2: Tuesday - Mossel Bay - Oudtshoorn

After breakfast, we head to Oudtshoorn and visit the Cape St Blaize Cave, site of one of South Africa's oldest archaeological excavations, known as the Cradle of Human Culture. We continue our journey to Oudtshoorn, the ostrich capital of the world and home to the spectacular limestone caverns of the Cango Caves. Visit an Ostrich Farm for a guided tour. Enjoy a wine tasting at a local wine estate in the scenic Schoemanshoek Valley, before setting off on a tour of the Cango Caves, one of the world's great natural wonders, sculpted by nature through the ages. Overnight in Oudtshoorn.

DAY 3: Wednesday - Oudtshoorn - Knysna

After breakfast, travel over the Outeniqua Pass to George, the sixth oldest town in South Africa, with many historical landmarks like the Slave Tree and King Edward VII Library building; said to be the best example of Edwardian architecture in the town. The tour travels via Wilderness, an attractive holiday resort, to Knysna, known as the oyster box of South Africa, nestling on the banks of a beautiful lagoon in the heart of the Garden Route. Journey into the magical Knysna Forests, the stamping ground of the elusive Knysna elephants. Discover the stories of the woodcutters who worked the forests, the elephants that were hunted to extinction and the discovery of gold. Visit the Dalene Matthee Big Tree Memorial. The enormous Yellowwood tree of over 880 years was named after Matthee, best known author of four books on the Knysna Forest. Enjoy a delicious lunch, before returning to Knysna. Overnight in Knysna.

DAY 4: Thursday – Knysna

Today you'll have the opportunity to further explore the natural beauty of the Knysna area. Visit the Forest Legends Museum, that exhibits tools and household items used by the woodcutters, the colourful Old Suzie steam engine, that was used to generate power, and the stately Old Forester's House, home of forester David Ernest Hutchins, who was the first person to manage the indigenous forest in a sustainable manner. Afterwards you'll have the opportunity to visit **Monkeyland Primate Sanctuary**, where you will be able to see a variety of primates, roaming free in the forest. This award-winning sanctuary is well known for its efforts to rehabilitate and free previously caged primates. The tour continues to the famous Eastern Head, where you will enjoy spectacular views of the Knysna Heads (weather permitting). Afterwards you'll travel to Brenton on Sea, a breath-taking holiday location and a nature lover's paradise with its unspoilt beaches and peaceful surroundings. The remainder of the afternoon will be at leisure. Overnight in Knysna.:

DAY 5: Friday - Knysna – Tsitsikamma

Travel to Plettenberg Bay, considered the jewel of the Garden Route, for a visit to the **Birds of Eden sanctuary**, the biggest single free flight aviary in the world. The sanctuary was developed to create a safe environment in which to release a large collection of free-flight African birds. Our journey continues to Bloukrans Bridge, the highest single span arch bridge in the world, currently offering the highest commercially operated Bungy Jump in the world. Visit the Tsitsikamma National Park and Storms River Mouth (weather permitting). The Tsitsikamma National Park incorporates 80 km of rocky coastline with spectacular sea and landscapes, a remote mountainous region with secluded valleys covered in mountain Fynbos and temperate high forests with deep river gorges leading down to the sea. Overnight in the Tsitsikamma area. [

DAY 6: Saturday - Tsitsikamma - Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth)

Head eastwards along the Tsitsikamma Forest to Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth), affectionately known as the "friendly city". Enjoy a city orientation tour of Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth), where the tour ends on arrival. Guests may disembark, on request, at Chief Dawid Stuurman Airport.



● ● BOTSWANA

● ● OKAVANGO DELTA – WILDERNESS JACANA CAMP (M) 2-NIGHTS, 3-DAYS EX MAUN AIRPORT

Set on an island and surrounded year-round by water, Jacana Camp is a quintessential Okavango Delta 'water camp'. The surrounding wetlands are densely populated with swamp specialists like sitatunga and red lechwe antelopes and the area abounds with hippo, elephant, crocodile, and other big game. It's also home to a rich variety of water birds including wattled cranes, Pel's fishing-owls, both species of jacanas as well as other seldom-seen species such as rails, crakes, and moorhens. Water-based activities such as fishing expeditions, boat trips and peaceful game viewing by mokoro (traditional dug-out canoe) make the most of these beautiful, watery surroundings. Walking safaris are offered year-round and, depending on water levels, game drives are available from about September to May as the floodwaters recede.



● ● OKAVANGO DELTA – WILDERNESS JAO CAMP (M) 2 NIGHTS, 3 DAYS EX MAUN AIRPORT

Set on a remote island and accessed only by air, Jao Camp is situated in the heart of the Okavango Delta and ensures a private and secluded experience in a classic African wilderness. Built on several levels and decorated with local carvings and artwork, Jao Camp also features excellent spa facilities and stunning scenery – little wonder then that Jao Camp has made such a name for itself. Head off in open 4x4 vehicles in search of the area's abundant wildlife: there's a great range of savannah species, wetland specialists and all the top predators such as lion, leopard, and hyena plus excellent birding. Set out in the evening for a night drive to spot the area's more elusive nocturnal creatures. And for something different, explore the Delta's waterways on a guided mokoro (dug-out canoe), spend the day fishing from a motorboat or explore nearby islands on foot, the best way to soak up the Okavango Delta's astounding natural beauty from another angle.



● ● OKAVANGO DELTA – WILDERNESS VUMBURA PLAINS (M) 2 NIGHTS, 3 DAYS EX MAUN AIRPORT

Vumbura Plains is as lavish and lush as its beautiful surroundings. Dreamy Delta waterways, green island woodlands and golden grasses, teeming with an ongoing wildlife parade; ever-changing with the seasons and always awe-inspiring. Move seamlessly between land and water experiences, navigating floodplains studded with ilala palms and small islands. Watch lions in pursuit of prey or African wild dogs, or a leopard, on the hunt. Catch glimpses of stately sable or, thrillingly, a shy sitatunga – almost invisible in its aquatic habitat among the papyrus. Vumbura Plains blends easily into its natural surroundings. Elegantly appointed suites, elevated on wooden decking, are set along the water's edge, each with a private viewing deck, plunge pool, sun loungers and a covered sala for siestas and private dining. Follow the walkway to the open lounge and dining room to enjoy the delectable cuisine a major highlight of your stay.



● ● OKAVANGO DELTA – WILDERNESS MOMBO CAMP: 2-NIGHTS, 3-DAYS EX MAUN AIRPORT - (MAY BE ADDED TO VICTORIA FALLS PACKAGE)

Steeped in history, Mombo maintains the traditions of the legendary original safari camp. In a thicket of giant mangosteen and fit trees, the spacious wood and canvas suites entice with sweeping views over an Okavango Delta floodplain teeming with wildlife. Wake up to an elephant silently ambling by your deck. Thrill to a lion hunt on the floodplain. Spot a rare Pel's fishing-owl or an endangered wattle crane. With over 45,000 hectares of exclusive private wilderness to explore, each day at Wilderness Mombo surprises and delights.



● ● VICTORIA FALLS | Zimbabwe Side

● ● VICTORIA FALLS HOTEL

This iconic hotel is the most romantic of all the hotels in the region. It is also the oldest and has the highest standards. Here you will find rooms in the colonial style but extremely comfortable. From the front lawns you will be able to see “The Smoke that Thunders” as the early people called the falls. Listen to the truly African sound of the marimbas as you sip cocktails at sunset and sine under the stars or in their colonial dining room as suits your taste.

This is a spot to do wonderful game viewing as well as visit the Victoria Falls and many activities as well. A mere 21 kms upstream from Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe, Chundu Island is a destination filled with unique experiences, magnificent views, friendly faces, and wildlife that enthrals. After the hustle and bustle of Vic Falls, a town that caters to both the adrenaline junkies and the curious, indulge in deliciously chilled island life. Chundu Island is an exclusive lodge with sole access to the beautiful 1.4km long island on the mighty Zambezi River. There is a 2.5-hour road transfer, including a short pontoon boat hop to the island. Or you can do the quick spectacular jet trip along the river. Positioned on the end of the Island, the welcome area is sure to entice. Our main lodge is wrapped around magnificent trees and boasts the most incredible views of the Zambezi River.
