Enhancing blood centers' service to hospital partners is a dedicated portal that provides a two-way connection to order activity, and other important information.

Complete with paper-free documentation of order activity and demand and production planning tools, HemaControl provides exceptional operational control for blood centers. When used with other InVita systems, hospital demand, operations planning, current inventory, donor recruitment, collections, product manufacturing, and quality control come together into one comprehensive view of operations at all levels and localities.

HemaControl empowers blood centers

From initial order request to packaging, transit, and delivery signature receipt, the HemaControl system enables blood center Hospital Services and Reference Lab staff to manage the entire lifecycle of hospital orders. Accessible from any device, HemaControl aggregates data from inventory, hospital orders, distribution, and recruitment activities to provide a centralized view of projected inventory.

Running parallel are the constant updates that impact inventory levels, such as outdates, quarantined units, imported and exported products, and specialty product requests. When these data points converge, inventory needs can be identified and addressed before they become urgent and more costly.

HemaControl removes the complexity of managing continuous change by automating the flow of information, organizing data, and sharing it simultaneously to the teams relying upon it. HemaControl evolves to meet the changing needs of blood centers. Most recent enhancements include:

- Chain of custody tracking with views of order progress for all stakeholders from order entry through delivery with signature to close out every order without paper.

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- GPS tracking of all shipments. Regardless of courier service, a robust mobile app provides blood center staff with one source for tracking their drivers' delivery progress, digital signatures displayed on the order history, and more.
- Driver Mobile App to complete orders with Digital signatures and is compliant with CFR 21 Part 11 regulations.
- Mobile app integration with traffic data to avoid costly delays and accommodate mid-day mobile drive pickups. The mobile app includes a transport map that not only shows mobile drive pickups but shows donor center locations, pending hospital order pickups, and the drivers current locations.
- An integrated billing module that makes invoicing and transfers seamless while streamlining the operations of your supply chain.

HemaControl enhances service to hospitals

HemaControl provides hospital partners with a user-friendly dashboard, branded to the blood center and providing a one-glance view of real-time order status, order history, distribution activity, etc. Hospital partners can provide their inventory updates right into the system and schedule recurring orders to ensure that critical blood products are available when needed.

In addition, hospitals have access to:

- Real-time chat with blood center staff for immediate assistance
- Reporting on fill rates, turnaround times, and canceled orders
- Invoicing documentation

HemaControl correspondingly supports automated email reports and automated text/email/cloud calls that can be configured to go out to hospital services when new orders come in and move through the different statuses.

- Staff have access to inventory and demand planning tools and reports that can be pushed to recruitment so activities are in sync.
- Staff can identify donors already on the appointment schedule who are conversion candidates for needed products with HemaConnect's FrontDesk.
